You are required to attend all mandatory athlete meetings and events of the convention, unless excused by the AEC <u>Admin Vice-Chair</u> or their designee. Failure to attend all mandatory athlete meetings (without an approved excuse) will result in disciplinary action by the USA Swimming Athletes' Executive Committee. All USA Swimming Safe Sport policies apply and will be enforced. You are responsible for familiarizing yourself with USA Swimming's Safe Sport policies.

VOTING INFORMATION

AEC Elections

Voting for AEC Elections will be conducted via ElectionRunner. If your LSC has designated you as a voting athlete, you have been designated a voting athlete by the AEC, or you are a voting member due to national committee status, the AEC will email your ballot prior to the election. If you have questions regarding your voting status for the AEC election or would like more clarification on the AEC election process, reach out to the AEC Admin Vice Chair.

Zone Elections

Voting for Zone Elections, legislation changes, and meet bids will be conducted via ElectionRunner. If your LSC has designated you as a voting athlete, you will receive an emailed ballot from the AEC and/or your Zone Board prior to each election. If you have questions regarding your voting status for the Zone elections or would like more clarification on the Zone election process, reach out to your respective Zone Athlete Representative.

USA Swimming House of Delegates

Voting for the USA Swimming House of Delegates will be conducted via conferencing voting software. If your LSC has designated you as a voting athlete, you have been designated a voting athlete by the AEC, or you are a voting member due to national committee status, you will receive your ballot via email from USA Swimming staff. If you have questions regarding your voting status for HOD or would like more clarification on the HOD process, reach out to the AEC Admin Vice Chair.

Election & Voting Etiquette

Campaigning for any position is NOT permitted. In a virtual environment, this includes, but is not limited to, actions such as soliciting votes, denigrating other candidates for the purpose of improving one's chances of winning, promising incentives or favors in return for election, or publishing a platform beyond what was included in the application and/or what may be said on the floor during the election. Please report any campaigning from a candidate to aec@usasathletes.org.

If you know you are a designated voting delegate but did not receive a ballot, check your spam folder. If you still cannot locate your ballot, email the <u>AEC Admin Vice Chair</u> with the subject line "MISSING BALLOT".

OTHER

Zone Athlete Rep Applications

If you would like to serve as a Senior or Junior Zone Athlete Representative for your respective zone, fill out this <u>application</u>. This form will be open until Saturday, September 12th at 11:59PM EST. Athlete Representatives may still run from the floor at the time of election.

National Committee Applications

National Committee duties and roles can be accessed <u>here</u>. If you are interested in serving on a USA Swimming National Committee, fill out the <u>USA Swimming National Committee application</u> and the <u>AEC Supplemental Athlete Form</u> no later than Sunday, October 4th, 2020. While not required, submitting the AEC form is strongly encouraged for your best chance at making a national committee.

Missing School

As we are not at a hotel this year away from your home, we hope you miss less school than before. However, if you need a student letter for hours missed from Thursday, September 24th- Saturday, September 26th, reach out to aec@usasathletes.org with the subject line "SCHOOL ABSENCE LETTER".

To be eligible for an athlete position on a USA Swimming National Committee, you must have competed in a USA Swimming sanctioned event within the past 24 months. If you are ineligible to serve as an athlete this year, we strongly encourage you to apply for a committee in a non-athlete capacity!
